IAF pilot killed as MiG-21 Bison crashes in Punjab field

Moga: An IAF MiG-21 Bison aircraft crashed during heavy rain in a field in Punjab's Moga district, killing its pilot Squadron Leader Abhinav Choudhary officials said.



The IAF has ordered a Court of Inquiry to ascertain the cause of the accident and said it condones the tragic loss of its officer.

Tarun Tejpal acquitted of rape charges

The Journalist Was Accused Of Sexually Assaulting Junior Colleague At A Goa Resort In 2013

Panaji: A sessions court in Goa on Friday acquitted journalist Tarun Tejpal of sexually assaulting a former female colleague. Tejpal, former Tehelka editor-in-chief, was accused of sexually assaulting the colleague inside the elevator of a luxury hotel in Goa in 2013.



Tejpal, who defended himself in the case, died of COVID-19 last week. The court had earlier adjourned pronouncement of the verdict in the case on three occasions, citing various reasons. The court was to deliver the verdict on April 27, but the judge had adjourned it to May 12. On May 12, it was further adjourned to May 28. However, it was again adjourned to May 21.

Goa govt to challenge verdict in HC: CM

Panaji: Goa chief minister Pramod Sawant on Friday said the state government will challenge in the high court journalist Tarun Tejpal's acquittal in a 2013 rape case by a district court here. "We will not tolerate any injustice to be meted out to the women in Goa. We will challenge the district court's order before the high court soon in this case," he told reporters. Sawant claimed that there was enough evidence against the accused.

Some of the activists pointed out that Tejpal had himself admitted to attempting to assault the woman and tendered apology and said the judgement is disappointing and demotivating.
